Nonaffiliates	 Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Nonaffiliates we share with can include companies, such as service providers engaged in direct marketing of consumer products and services we believe would be of interest to you, or which are necessary in the service of your account. A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market
Joint Marketing	 A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include auto dealers, insurance companies, and membership clubs.
